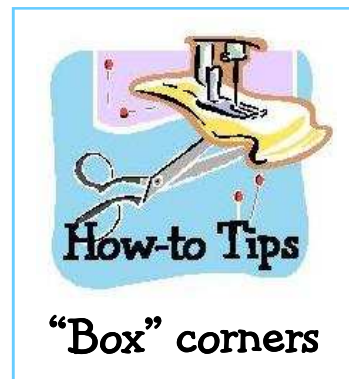




REDdelicious



Boxed corners are a simple method of making a wide base on the bottom of a bag.

The body of the bag is two pieces of fabric, which you have stitched around the sides and bottom.

To box the bottom corners keep the bag inside out, then:

- Trim diagonally across the bottom corners and press open the seams.
- Open the bag wide and fold down each side seam to meet the bottom seam and pin in place.
  - Tip:* Look inside the bag to make sure you have the two seams lined up.
- Measure in from the point and mark where you want to form the box.
  - Tip:* the further from the point you make this line, the wider the base of the bag will be. On this example the line is 1.25" in from the point to make a base 2" wide.
- Stitch across at this line.
- You can trim off the outer triangles of fabric, or just push them flat when you turn the bag right side out.
